

### **Rules for Conduct of Club Bowling Events.**

The Match Committee met at the club rooms to determine both fair and equitable rules for the conduct and conclusion of club events as noted in the club calendar. These events have been conducted over many years and the general committee has asked the match committee to ensure the events are concluded within a reasonable time to allow for an outcome that is both fair and timely to all participants.

To achieve these goals the following rules for the conduct of club bowling events have been created by unanimous resolution of the match committee.

1. Participants are required to ensure their name is placed on the list displayed at the club room prior to the completion of a draw;
2. All participants are required to play on the day of the nominated first round;
3. A match committee member will conduct a draw of players prior to play commencing. This may be done prior to the date or on the day of the first match depending on numbers and circumstances;
4. During the progress of the event and after the first day of the event, participants are required to complete further rounds of play within time frames as specified by the match committee and
5. In the event of failure to complete a round within specified time frames, the match committee depending on circumstances may, extend the time for completion by setting a mandatory date, declare a specific winner or declare all players in that drawn round as non-winners.
